Sherry M. Knowles, Esq. is Senior Vice President and Chief Intellectual Property Counsel of GlaxoSmithKline, where she serves as the worldwide head of patents and trademarks for both litigation and transactional matters. Ms. Knowles joined GSK in September 2006. Prior to that, she was a partner in and founder of the Biotechnology and Pharmaceutical Intellectual Property Practice at King & Spalding LLP, where she represented companies, foundations and universities in connection with patent prosecution, litigation, contracts, licensing, financing and other corporate intellectual property issues relating to pharmaceutical, biotechnology and chemical inventions. Ms. Knowles received her B.S., *cum laude*, with distinction in chemistry from Duke University and received her M.S. in organic chemistry from Clemson University. Prior to attending law school, she spent several years at SmithKline Beecham (now GlaxoSmithKline) as a pharmaceutical synthetic chemist. She received her J.D., *magna cum laude*, from the University of Georgia where she was a Benjamin Phillips Scholar and was elected to the Order of the Coif.

Ms. Knowles is a frequent speaker on key issues relating to intellectual property matters that affect the pharmaceutical and biotechnology industries. *Managing Intellectual Property Magazine* (July/August 2008) named Ms. Knowles as one of the top ten most influential people in IP in the world, and a “Patent Owner’s Advocate.”
