The Honorable Arthur J. Gajarsa, was nominated to the United States Court of Appeals for the Federal Circuit by former President William Jefferson Clinton, and was confirmed by the Senate on July 31, 1997. He entered service on September 12, 1997.

In his legal career, the judge practiced administrative and corporate law which included extensive practice before various federal government agencies. He also had an active litigation practice in Native American water and land rights and intellectual property law.

Judge Gajarsa received his B.S.E.E. from Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute, Troy, New York in 1962. He then pursued and received his M.A. in international economics from Catholic University of America, Washington, D.C. and also received his J.D. from Georgetown University Law Center in 1967.
